

Vision Basketball Player Code of Conduct

By joining the Vision Basketball program, I agree to uphold the following commitments and represent Vision Basketball with Christlike character through the way I compete, communicate, and treat others.

1. Coachability

I will demonstrate attentiveness, diligence, and a teachable spirit by listening to my coaches and giving my best effort to carry out their instructions.

2. Faithfulness

I will attend all scheduled practices and games on time. If I must miss a practice or game or arrive late, I will notify my coach or team coordinator ahead of time.

3. Modesty & Orderliness

I will dress appropriately and modestly for all practices and games.

Vision players will follow these standards:

- Young men will wear shirts at all times and keep their shorts pulled up appropriately.
- Young ladies will not wear exposing tank-style shirts or open midriff shirts.
- Shorts must be loose-fitting, basketball-style, and at least mid-thigh in length.
- All undergarments must remain covered at all times.

4. Attitude & Self-Control

I will maintain a positive, teachable attitude regardless of my playing time, whether officiating is fair, or whether my team wins or loses. I will control my emotions and demonstrate patience, especially toward teammates, opponents, and officials.

5. Respect for Others

I will show respect for my coaches, teammates, opponents, officials, and the Vision Basketball community. I will encourage others, especially younger or less experienced players, and I will not ridicule, taunt, gossip about, or speak disparagingly toward others.

6. Responsibility

I will follow the rules established by my team and coaches. I will avoid horseplay before, during, or after practices and games, and I will treat all facilities and equipment with care.

7. Communication

I will communicate with my coaches regarding any sickness, fatigue, or injury that could affect my ability to safely participate in practices or games. This includes communicating symptoms of excessive fatigue during competition or practice.

8. Teamwork

I understand that Vision Basketball emphasizes teamwork and team concepts over individual recognition. I will use my words and actions to encourage my teammates, build fellowship, and strengthen unity within the Vision Basketball program.
