

Vision Basketball Parent/Guardian Code of Conduct

By allowing my child to participate in Vision Basketball, I recognize that I play an important role in supporting the program, my child, and the Vision Basketball community. I commit to the following:

1. Support Academic Responsibility

I will ensure that my player is maintaining their studies and a grade point average of at least 2.0 on a 4.0 scale. If my child is not maintaining satisfactory academic progress, I will notify the coach and/or Vision Board.

2. Support Team Expectations

I will encourage my player to follow the Vision Basketball Player Code of Conduct and all team rules and program guidelines.

3. Model Christlike Character & Sportsmanship

I will be a positive example for my player by demonstrating self-control and respect before, during, and after practices and games. I will:

- Support and encourage my child, coaches, teammates, opponents, and officials by maintaining a positive and respectful sideline presence.
- Allow coaches to coach, avoid negative comments, and appreciate good plays by all players.

4. Encourage a Positive Attitude

I will take an active interest in my player's attitude and help them understand that attitude reflects character. I will reinforce that good sportsmanship and character are more important than winning. I will avoid speaking negatively about coaches, players, or the program, including in conversations with my child.

5. Support the Vision Program

I will complete all required forms, pay all required fees, and willingly accept an active volunteer role during the season. If I am unable to fulfill my responsibilities, I will take responsibility for finding a substitute when needed.

6. Follow the Vision Communication & Resolution Process

If I have an issue or concern involving someone connected to Vision Basketball, I will follow the proper process:

1. I will first contact the individual involved and seek resolution directly.
2. If the issue cannot be resolved, I will involve a Vision Board Member for clarification and assistance.
3. If further assistance is needed, the Vision Board Member will determine whether the matter should be brought before the full Vision Board.

7. Respect Coaching Decisions

I understand that Vision Basketball is a competitive program and that playing time and game decisions are determined by the coaching staff based on what they believe is best for the team and its players.

I will respect the coaching process by addressing concerns with the coach or Athletic Director at an appropriate time, not before, during, or immediately following practices or games.

I understand that my actions impact my child, the team, and the Vision Basketball community. Disrespectful behavior or failure to uphold this Code of Conduct may result in disciplinary action, including removal from the program without refund of fees.
